Janette Burgin Head Basketball Coach



Janette Burgin was named head coach of the Wildcats women's basketball program on Nov. 6, 2013.

In 10 seasons, Burgin went from four victories in her first season to back-to-back 20 win seasons the next two years, including a 22-9 mark in 2015-16. In 2018-19, the Wildcats finished 19-14 overall and advanced all the way to the championship game of the Heart of America Athletic Conference Tournament as the seventh seed.

In 2020, Burgin directed the Wildcats to their third 20-win season in her tenure, finishing with a 20-11 overall record, and earned their first trip to the NAIA Division I Women's National Tournament.

Burgin has coached 26 all-conference players, three NAIA All-American's and 41 NAIA Scholar-Athletes. In 2016, the Wildcats had eight players named NAIA Scholar-Athletes, the most in the NAIA.

Burgin began her coaching career at Central Methodist University in Fayette, Mo., helping guide the Eagles to the NAIA National Tournament in 2013.

Ryan Dooley Assistant Basketball Coach



Ryan Dooley joined the women's basketball staff prior to the 2022-23 season as an assistant coach.

At Culver-Stockton College, Dooley was tabbed for multiple conference and national awards over her 60 career games while helping C-SC to a conference title game appearance in 2018-19 and a national tournament appearance in 2019-20. She was named to the All-Heart first team in 2020 after earning second team honors in 2019. An NAIA All-America honorable mention selection in 2020, Dooley was named 2018-19 C-SC Newcomer of the Year, 2019-20 C-SC Female Athlete of the Year, and a 2019-20 NSCA All-American Strength and Conditioning Athlete.

Dooley is a native of Assumption, Illinois, where she attended Central A&M High School (Moweaqua, Illinois) and played basketball. The guard was named to the AP and IBCA All-State team three times.
