Janette Burgin Head Basketball Coach



Janette Burgin was named head coach of the Wildcats women's basketball program on Nov. 6, 2013.

In 10 seasons, Burgin went from four victories in her first season to back-to-back 20 win seasons the next two years, including a 22-9 mark in 2015-16. In 2018-19, the Wildcats finished 19-14 overall and advanced all the way to the championship game of the Heart of America Athletic Conference Tournament as the seventh seed.

In 2020, Burgin directed the Wildcats to their third 20-win season in her tenure, finishing with a 20-11 overall record, and earned their first trip to the NAIA Division I Women's National Tournament.

Burgin has coached 29 all-conference players, three NAIA All-American's and 47 NAIA Scholar-Athletes. In 2016, the Wildcats had eight players named NAIA Scholar-Athletes, the most in the NAIA.

Burgin began her coaching career at Central Methodist University in Fayette, Mo., helping guide the Eagles to the NAIA National Tournament in 2013.

Makayla Wallace Assistant Basketball Coach



Makayla Wallace completed her first season as an assistant coach with the Wildcat women's basketball program in 2024-25.

Wallace comes to Culver-Stockton after completing her collegiate career at Lindenwood University in St. Charles, Mo.

Wallace helped Kirkwood (Mo.) High School to back-to-back Missouri Class 5 Girls Basketball State Championships in 2017 and 2018 before heading off to the

University of Evansville where she appeared in 30 games, including 20 starts, as a freshman.

After two years at Evansville, Wallace moved to the University of North Dakota where she played in five games of the Covid-shortened season of 2020-21. Wallace missed her entire senior season at North Dakota due to injury before finishing her career at Lindenwood.

Wallace set the Lindenwood single season record for steals, surpassing the old record of 60 with a five-steal game against Southern Illinois-Edwardsville on February 15th and finishing with 72 steals on the season, including a career-high seven-steal effort in a double overtime win against Tennessee State.

Megan Diehl just concluded her first season as a graduate assistant after playing three-plus seasons with the Wildcats.

During her tenure, Diehl appeared in 82 career games, scoring 236 career points and averaging 2.9 points and 3.0 rebounds per game.

Diehl was named a Daktronics-NAIA Scholar Athlete three straight years during her time on the Hill.
